TRAVEL INSURANCE is compulsory. We **highly recommend** the purchase of a Travel Insurance Policy at the same time as payment of your deposit. This should cover you prior to departure for unforeseen cancellations.

PILGRIMAGE CONDITIONS

PLEASE READ THESE TERMS CAREFULLY. ENROLMENT AND PAYMENT OF A DEPOSIT FOR THE PILGRIMAGE CONSTITUTES ACCEPTANCE OF THESE TERMS. Upon payment of the Deposit, the Registration Form forms part of the Terms and the agreement between the pilgrim and Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality.

MINIMUM NUMBERS AND CANCELLATION OF TRIP BY US:

Your booking for the ground content of the pilgrimage is not confirmed until Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality provides written confirmation that the minimum number requirements have been met. The price of pilgrimage is based on minimum number requirements of 15 paying passengers for the Pilgrimage (unless Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality advises otherwise in writing). Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality reserves the right to cancel any booking in accordance with operating requirements, in circumstances beyond its control or if minimum numbers are not met. In the event that we cancel (or not proceed with) your booking due to insufficient numbers, we will refund all money paid by you towards the ground content price. Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality is not responsible for expenses incurred by passengers for other travel arrangements including airfares affected by a cancellation.

CONFIRMATION OF BOOKING:

Please note: Confirmation of Booking will be despatched approximately 2-3 weeks prior to your departure.

GROUP PACKAGE PRICE:

- **HOTELS AND PILGRIM REFUGES:** The cost of the ground content as offered is based upon a busload of 15 paying passengers for the Pilgrimage. Failure to reach this number may result in a price increase. Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality reserves the right to ask pilgrims of the same gender to share accommodation. The accommodation in the pilgrim refuges will be shared, sometimes in bunk beds, often in double rooms. In some places we can offer some single rooms.
- **MEALS:** Meals consisting of service provider standard supplied breakfasts, lunches (except on 3 days), and dinners are included throughout the Pilgrimage as per your itinerary.
- **SIGHTSEEING:** Local transportation by air-conditioned coach, the services of an English speaking guide and the entrance fees to places visited on the Pilgrimage described in the itinerary are included in the Pilgrimage price.
- **SERVICE CHARGES and TAXES:** Service charges and taxes imposed by foreign facilities in connection with the services provided as part of the Pilgrimage are included.
- **NOT INCLUDED:** Your airfare to and from Spain, transport to Loyola, any excess baggage, items of personal nature such as laundry, beverages, meals other than included in your itinerary, transportation from your hometown to the airport of departure and vice versa, travel insurance, personal expense money, medical fees, phone calls, tips, items of a personal nature, and costs resulting from absence or deviation from the itinerary and any items not shown in these Terms as being included.

TRANSPORTATION: It is the pilgrim's sole responsibility to purchase flights and organise their own travel to Loyola. Pilgrims will need to arrive in Loyola on Tuesday 8 May, 2018. The pilgrimage finishes in Barcelona.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS: It is the pilgrim's sole responsibility to ensure that they have a valid passport (and is valid for at least 6 months beyond the end of the Pilgrimage) and all visas and permits (if any) for the Pilgrimage.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: All pilgrims must have appropriate travel insurance to cover them from unforeseen cancellations or events. Travel Insurance must be purchased prior to departure from a travel insurance provider. Travel insurance should include cover for hospitalization, doctor and prescription expenses, medical evacuation back to your home country, cover for travel delays and missed connections, loss of luggage etc. Comprehensive travel insurance is strongly recommended.

CANCELLATION OF BOOKING AND CANCELLATION CHARGES:

In the event that you cancel your booking:

- Deposit is non refundable.
- Cancellation within 61 days and 120 days of departure, pilgrim will forfeit the deposit plus 50% all other payments.
- Cancellation within 60 days of departure will result in no refund.

In the event that due payment dates are not met and contact has not been made with the Pilgrimage organizer at Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality, the pilgrim is deemed to have cancelled.

REFUNDS: All cancellations and claims for refunds (which are allowed under these Terms) must be made prior to departure in writing directly to Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality. No refund shall be provided to passengers who do not use services or items included in the Pilgrimage on or after the departure date.

If you fail to join the pilgrimage, join it after departure or leave it prior to completion, no refund will be made.

ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND VARIATIONS

Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality agrees to arrange for the ground content of the pilgrimage as outlined in the itinerary provided by Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality and subject to these terms and this represents the entire agreement between the passenger and Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality. No changes or deviations are effective unless authorised by Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality in writing or are required to be made by Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality due to operational requirements of service providers for circumstances beyond Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality's reasonable control. No other person, except for Fr. Josep Lluís Iriberrí, SJ - Director Oficina del Peregrino del Camino Ignaciano or his delegate, is authorised to adjust, modify, cancel or change this program, to make any representation or warranty concerning the Pilgrimage. The Pilgrimage Guide in conjunction with Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality reserves the right to decline any registration.

SERVICE PROVIDERS AND AGENCY

Transport service providers are not to be held responsible for any act, omission or event during the time the passengers are not in a vehicle or conveyance.

The passenger contracts directly with each service provider in respect to each service obtained (when such service is not directly provided by Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality) as agent for the passenger. Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality agrees to use due skill and care in making such bookings. When tickets or confirmation of services are issued by service providers to the passenger, such ticket or confirmation constitutes the sole and entire contract between the service provider and the passenger, and Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality assumes no liability or any responsibility in connection to such booking. Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality is not a carrier and does not own any hotels, aircraft, bus or other vehicles used in the Pilgrimage. All bookings with service providers are subject to the service provider's terms and conditions of sale and any limitation of liability imposed by such service providers. Service providers may limit, restrict or exclude liability in respect to personal injury, death, delays and loss or damage to baggage and belongings.

LIABILITY OF OPERATOR

To the extent permitted by law, Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality does not accept any liability in contract, tort or otherwise for any injury, damage, loss (including consequential or special loss), accidents, schedule changes, irregularity, incidental damages, delay, additional expense or inconvenience caused directly or indirectly by the acts, omissions or default, whether negligent or otherwise, of service providers over whom we have no direct control, force majeure or any other event which is beyond our reasonable control. Under circumstances where liability cannot be excluded and where liability may be lawfully limited, such liability is limited to the value of the purchased travel arrangements or the costs of re-supplying the goods and services whichever is the lesser. Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality assumes no responsibility for acts or omissions on the part of the Pilgrimage guide. Nothing in these terms is intended to limit any rights you may have under the Competition and Consumer Act 1510 (Cth) or the Australian Consumer Law.

INVALIDITY

The provisions of the Terms are severable, and if any provision of the Terms is held to be invalid or unenforceable, such provision may be removed and the remaining provisions shall be enforced.

JURISDICTION

This agreement shall be deemed to have been made in the state of Victoria and shall be governed by the law of that state and the parties further submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of that state. Notwithstanding this clause, Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality relies on and receives the benefits of international conventions, national and international law in respect to air travel and transportation which may apply to the services provided by service providers and Campion Centre of Ignatian Spirituality.
